ENTRIES:

Entries must be submitted or postmarked no later than **JUNE 10, 2024**.

Entries can be completed online at HorseShowsOnline.com by **JUNE 10, 2024** (instructions at back of prize list for creating a HorseShowsOnline account). Stall reservations and pre-orders for bedding can also be completed online at HorseShowsOnline.com when completing your entries.

Entries can also be completed using the fillable PDF official entry forms (one horse per entry form; there are separate entry forms for performance and academy classes) found on the website (www.midamericasaddlebred.org) and then emailed to the show at sblome67@aol.com by **JUNE 10, 2024** or can be printed and mailed (postmarked no later than **JUNE 10, 2024**) to:

Copies of registration papers, current negative Coggins, and out of state health papers should be brought to show office when checking in. Open checks may be established at the show.

DO NOT MAIL ENTRIES AFTER JUNE 10, 2024.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

All horses must have negative Coggins test dated within 12 months of show. An official health certificate issued within 30 days of the show by a licensed veterinarian must accompany all horses not residing in the State of Missouri. The health and negative Coggins certificates must be available for inspection at the time of check-in.

Payment of fees can be made by cash, check, or credit card.

STABLING:

Stalls are available in the brick barns (including mule barn) and pole barns. All stalls have doors. Stalls available at 10:00am on Friday, June 21, 2024. If stalls are needed before Friday, June 21, 2024, contact the Show Manager to see if arrangements can be made. An early arrival fee of \$9 per stall will be assessed for arrival before Friday, June 21, 2024.

End of Show: All horses and equipment must be removed from the premises by 6:00pm on Sunday, June 23, 2024.

Each horse entered is required to have a stall.

ARENAS:

The Coliseum will be used for all show sessions EXCEPT for the Ranch classes on Saturday and Sunday mornings which will be held in Donnelly Arena. The Coliseum will be closed for two 10-minute periods on Friday, June 21st to allow each of the Drill Teams a chance to practice their routine in the Coliseum. The times of the closures will be announced and posted on Facebook and at the show office as soon as they are available.

BEDDING:

Shavings (\$11/bag) are requested to be pre-ordered (this can be done through online entry or by emailing/ mailing your entries). Shavings can also be ordered at the show office during the show (please note that a one to two hour wait will apply). Go to the show office or contact the Show Manager to place your order. Shavings must be purchased through the show. No outside bedding allowed.

ACADEMY / ACADEMY SHOWCASE CLASSES

Academy will follow the MHSA rules (which in turn follows the ASHBA's Horse Show Academy Division Guidelines). Information regarding Academy rules can be found on the horse show's website www.midamericasaddlebred.org in the MHSA Rulebook for 2022-2024 and in the ASHBA Academy Guidelines. All Academy classes are Saddle Seat unless otherwise specified. No cross entry between W/T and W/T/C classes or Performance and Academy classes.

Class #37 is open to any riders in classes #16 and #18 and are 10 years of age or older. If more than 8 riders sign up for class #37, the class will be split into sections. Class #39 is open to any riders in classes #20, #22, #24 and #26 and are 10 years of age or older. If more than 8 riders sign up for class #39, the class will be split into sections. If you have a rider who qualifies for either of these classes and wishes to participate, please go to the show office to enter your rider(s). The riders qualified for each class must be entered by 5pm on Saturday, June 22nd if they wish to show in either of these classes.

The Mid-America Charity Horse Show is held in compliance with all laws and regulations of the United States of America and the State of Missouri. All exhibitors are notified to comply therewith with special reference to the Horse Protection Act of 1970 as amended.

NOTE: The Mid-America Charity Horse Show qualifies for the Monarch National Championships and it is a qualifying show for the Kentucky State Fair World's Championships. The Mid-America Charity Horse Show is also an ASHBA Star show and a double point MHSA show.

Our horse show will offer online entries through HorseShowsOnline.com (HSO). Below are some instructions to get you started with your online account.

First, you will need to go to HorseShowsOnline.com to register for your free account. When you get to the home screen, look on the right side and click the link that says Login or create an account .

Simply fill in all the required information, agree to the terms of service, create your login ID and password. Now you are ready to start setting up your account.

Once you are on your home page, look for a tab that says My people, horses, and shows near the top of the page. Click on that tab. This is where you will be setting up your online entries.

First you need to click on Add a new person . Horse owners need to be created before any horses can be added. Once you have all your owners and riders in the system, you can move on to horses.

To enter a horse, click on the tab that says Horses and follow the same process as when you added people. It may take some time to get all of this information entered in, but it will be worth it in the end. You only have to enter it one time and it will permanently stay in your account.

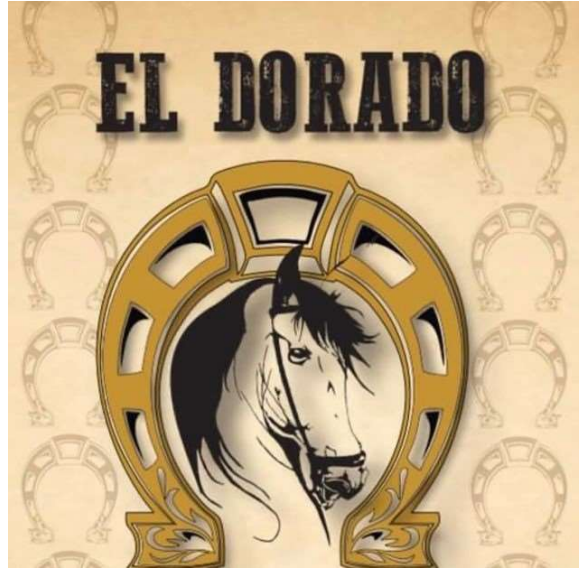
Once everything is entered in, you can use this information for every show that you enter on HorseShowsOnline.

When it is time to enter a show, you will click on the tab that says Show entries (it is next to the people and horses tabs in your account). Click on the pencil icon that says Enter a show - Create a new online entry . You can also enter a show by going to the Show Selector tab and clicking on the show you wish to enter. If the show you choose is correct, click OK - start an new entry .

Fill in the required information for each step. The online entry wizard will guide you through each step to complete the entry form. Review your entry and then click Checkout to submit the new entry. The last step of checking out will generate the final entry form, and will submit to the show secretary for review and acceptance.

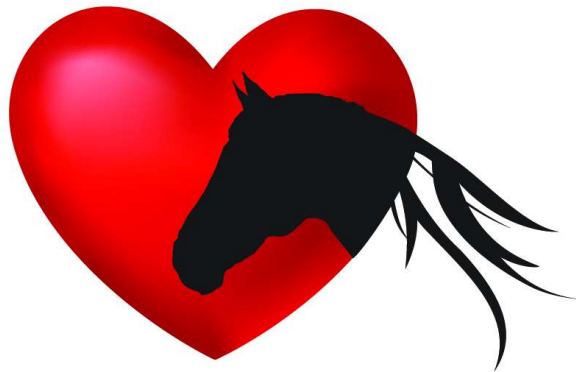
If you start an entry, and do not have time to finish, you can come back anytime to work on it. Unfinished entry forms can be found under the My entries tab.
