ENTRIES:

Entries must be submitted or postmarked no later than **JUNE 16, 2026**.

Entries can be completed online at HorseShowsOnline.com through **JUNE 16, 2026** (instructions at back of prize list for creating a HorseShowsOnline account). Stall reservations and pre-orders for bedding can also be completed online at HorseShowsOnline.com when completing your entries.

Copies of registration papers, current negative Coggins, and out-of-state health papers should be brought to Show Office when checking in. Open checks may be established at the show.

DO NOT MAIL ENTRIES AFTER JUNE 16, 2026.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

All horses must have a negative Coggins test dated within 12 months of show. An official health certificate issued within 30 days of the show by a licensed veterinarian must accompany all horses not residing in the State of Missouri. The health and negative Coggins certificates must be available for inspection at the time of check-in.

Brick barns: \$90

Early arrival fee (per stall): \$10

Academy: \$25 (including Academy Showcase)

Performance: \$35

Post Entry Fee (entries received or postmarked after June 16, 2026): \$10

Payment of fees can be made by cash, check, credit card, or Venmo.

STABLING:

Stalls are available in the brick barns only. All stalls have doors.

Start of Show: Stalls are available at 10:00am on Friday, June 26, 2026. If stalls are needed before Friday, June 26, 2026, contact the Show Manager to make arrangements for early arrival. An early arrival fee of \$10 per stall will be assessed for arrival before Friday, June 26, 2026.

End of Show: All horses and equipment must be removed from the premises by 6:00pm on Sunday, June 28, 2026.

Each horse entered is required to have a stall.

ARENAS:

The Coliseum will be used for all show sessions.

BEDDING & HAY:

Shavings (\$12/bag) are requested to be pre-ordered (this can be done through online entry, emailing/ mailing your entries, or contacting the Show Manager). Shavings can also be ordered at the show office during the show (please note that a wait will apply as the shavings are not on site and have to be brought in). Go to the show office or contact the Show Manager to place your order. Shavings must be purchased through the show. No outside bedding allowed.

Brome hay (\$14/bale) is requested to be pre-ordered (this can be done through online entry, emailing/ mailing your entries, or contacting the Show Manager) in order to be supplied by the show. Hay can also be ordered at the show office during the (please note that a wait will apply as the hay is not on site and has to be brought in). Go to the show office or contact the Show Manager to place your order.

ACADEMY / ACADEMY SHOWCASE CLASSES:

Academy will follow the ASHBA's Horse Show Academy Division Guidelines. All Academy classes are Saddle Seat unless otherwise specified. No cross entry between W/T and W/T/C classes or Performance and Academy classes. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 6th in all classes. 1st place will also receive a small trophy.

Class #40 is open to any riders who showed in class #18 or #20 who are 14 years of age or older. Class #43 is open to any riders who showed in class #20 who are 13 years of age or younger. Class #45 is open to any riders who showed in class #22, #24, or #26 who are 13 years of age or older. Class #48 is open to any riders who showed in class #26, #28, or #30 who are 12 years of age or younger. If you have a rider who qualifies for any of these classes and wishes to participate, please go to the show office to enter your rider(s). The riders qualified for each class must be entered by 5pm on Saturday, June 27th if they wish to show in any of these classes.

A \$10 bill will be randomly stapled to one ribbon that is handed out in each of the Academy classes courtesy of a generous sponsor of the show!

ASHBA JUNIOR JUDGING:

The ASHBA Junior Judging program was developed to educate youth by expanding their understanding of class and show procedures, conduct, specifications, and priorities for judging the American Saddlebred horse. The Mid-America Charity Horse Show is pleased to announce that it will have a Junior Judging contest during the Sunday morning session!

Sign up in the office to participate by the end of the Academy session on Saturday. There will be a meeting before the Saturday evening session (time to be announced) to go over instructions and determine the classes that will be included in the Junior Judging contest.

Judging will be split between 13 & under and 14 & over. 1st through 6th place in each age division will receive a ribbon and a goodie bag. 1st place will also receive a trophy.
